Academic Assessment Assistantship (half-time, 20 hr/week)

Qualifications

Required

- Doctoral students who have completed all coursework and advanced to candidacy.
- Experience designing and conducting research projects that address teaching and learning issues.
- Experience with assessment at the course and/or program level.
- Interest in teaching enhancement and faculty development from any discipline.

Beneficial, but not required

- Teaching experience with a variety of course formats (e.g., lecture, lab, seminar, recitation)

Responsibilities

1. Support University-wide program assessment efforts by:
 - a. helping to keep the Web site updated,
 - b. collecting, analyzing and reporting on data related to the efforts, and
 - c. collaborating on consultations, presentations and workshops related to program and/or course assessment.
2. Support the work of Schreyer Institute staff in developing Web resources on a variety of teaching and learning topics and/or developing materials for workshops and presentations.
